





# ICBND Distinguished Community Banker Award

The Distinguished Community Banker Award was created in 1998 by the Board of Directors to recognize the efforts of its most outstanding members. It is the most prestigious award given by ICBND.

The award, which need not be given every year, honors a community banker or someone who was a community banker for exemplary and outstanding service to community banking over an extended career. The community banker selected will have served at the local and state level and may have served at the national level as well. The recipient may be an active community banker or may be someone who is retired or deceased.

The recipient may be nominated by a member of the ICBND Board of Directors or the Blue Ribbon Committee, and is selected only after receiving a 2/3 affirmative vote by the ICBND Board of Directors and a 2/3 affirmative vote of the Blue Ribbon Committee members voting. The award is presented at the annual convention.

This year's Distinguished Community Banker was awarded posthumous to Leland Stenehjem. Lee graduated from NDSU and served America as a Marine during WWII. He came home to ND, married Judy and together they raised their family while he shepherded the growth of First International Bank and Trust.


Lee and Judy were pillars of strength for their church and community. He believed that the bank was the lifeblood of the community and you could not have a great bank without having a thriving and successful community. Lee believed that as a banker you had a responsibility to help your clients. He taught his employees to protect the depositor's investment in the bank like they would protect the dollars of our grandmother.

Lee saw the importance of having one solid voice for community banking and was a great supporter of Independent Community Banks of North Dakota. His lifelong commitment to ICBA was built in 1964-65 when he served as National President.

Lee lived a life built upon values of faith, family, forward thinking, personal responsibility, honesty, integrity and excellence. Accepting the award on behalf of Lee were his children Leland Stenehjem, Jr, Judy Rustvang, and Stephen Stenehjem.

A tribute to Lee was read and shown in a video presentation and the award was presented by longtime friend and co-worker Dennis Walsh. Comments were also given by sons, Lee, Jr and Steve (pictured below).
