



Legislative Update March 5, 2021

SECTION 1: GENERAL

It was a short week at the Capitol as the assembly was in crossover recess Monday and Tuesday and activities relative to ICBND's tracking list were minimal. But it was certainly not without drama given the harassment allegations against Representative Luke Simons that were released late last week. House and caucus leadership had asked Representative Simons to resign his post in the House. He denied that request and has also denied wrongdoing. As a result, the full House assembled as a "Committee of the Whole" Thursday afternoon for reportedly the first time in over 50 years to address the allegations against Representative Simons.

Thursday's House Floor session was a unique and historic event that began awkwardly and clumsily with a 47-46 vote to allow the Speaker to preside followed by a great deal of confusion over which version of the resolution the body was to be addressing. They were nearly an hour into the session before the resolution calling for expulsion of Representative Simons was actually presented. Proponents and opponents of the measure argued their respective case related to this somber issue. Shortly before 5 pm last evening, the House voted 69-25 to expel Representative Simons narrowly achieving the two-thirds majority necessary for such an action.

SECTION 2: OTHER BILL UPDATES FROM ICBND "PRIORITY" TRACKING LIST

HB 1398 – is a bill that seeks to preempt political subdivisions from mandating that businesses provide paid family medical leave in excess of what's required by state or federal law. It was heard Wednesday morning in the Senate Industry, Business and Labor Committee. ICBND and the general business lobby support the legislation while representatives of the teachers' union, the AFL-CIO and the League of Cities opposed the measure. The Committee did not act on the measure but it's clear that the majority support the legislation. I expect it to receive a strong "Do Pass" recommendation.

SB 2019 – is the Career and Technical Education budget and it was heard this morning in the House Appropriations Committee – Education and Environment Division. Of particular interest to ICBND and its members is the Adult Farm Management Program. ICBND provided testimony in support of the governor's recommended budget (\$1,756,138) which has been approved by the Senate. The Committee did not act on the budget yet as there are lots of moving parts in the budget.

SB 2048 – is a measure that revises and updates the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act. The last update to this language occurred in 1981 by the Uniform Law Commission and was adopted into North Dakota statute in 1985. It's a torturous 54-page read but does provide some necessary and important updates for community banks and their customers. ICBND supports the bill and it received a 11-1-2 "Do Pass" recommendation.

SB 2191 – relates to the disposal of abandoned personal property. The North Dakota Land Title Association introduced this bill as a companion bill to SB 2205 which passed last session. SB 2205 streamlined abandoned real property foreclosures. That bill was successful in shortening the foreclosure time frame for lenders. As a part of that process, the foreclosing bank and law firm also run into problems

with abandoned personal property left in the property which causes delays. This bill would streamline the personal property process as SB 2205 did last session for real property. ICBND supports the bill which was heard yesterday morning in the House Political Subdivision Committee. The Committee did not act on the bill, however, as Representative Ertelt had a number of questions for the bill proponents.
